### CONDITIONS

1. Fellowships are available for graduate study in organized institutions of higher learning located in the United States of America, as well as independent research or study projects, which must be carried out entirely in the United States of America.
2. Applications and supporting documents must be submitted through the Dean of the University the applicant attends; each University is only permitted to submit three candidates for review.
3. The Candidate must demonstrate a need for financial assistance and must be enrolled in an accredited college or university in the United States.
4. The Candidate must have received a baccalaureate degree and have an outstanding undergraduate record.
5. The Candidate must be a citizen of the United States of America.
6. The program of study being pursued by the Candidate need not be limited to Armenian studies; it may include any recognized field of study in the humanities, social sciences, or natural sciences (including law, medicine, engineering, architecture or other formal professional training).
7. The Candidate may be of any national descent or background.
8. In her Will, Dolores Zohrab Liebmann stated that:

"It is my desire that no benefit from such Fellowships or scholarships be enjoyed by any person who, or institution which, supports, advocates or upholds the principles and doctrines of Communism."

Accordingly:
  - (a) If the Candidate or the institution supports, advocates or upholds the principles and doctrines of Communism, the Trustee reserves the right to reject the application.
  - (b) The Trustee also reserves the right to require the Candidate to submit an affidavit, affirmed or sworn to before a Notary Public, confirming that he or she does not support, advocate or uphold the principles and doctrines of Communism.
9. The amount of each Fellowship will cover actual tuition costs plus a flat stipend to be allocated towards room, board and ordinary living expenses, as well as any income taxes thereon.
10. The recipient of a Fellowship shall be known as a Dolores Zohrab Liebmann Fellow.

11. The University and Fellow must promptly answer all notices and letters relating to the Fellowship.
12. A Fellowship may be canceled at any time if a Fellow engages in misconduct affecting the Fund, breaches any of these rules or provides false information to the Fund either directly or indirectly.
13. Fellowships are awarded annually. Each Fellow MUST APPLY FOR A RENEWAL of his or her Fellowship by March 30 of the following year in accordance with the terms in effect at the time the Fellowship is awarded. Fellowships will be limited to a maximum of three years.
14. A Fellow shall be required to submit periodic progress reports. For renewals, a Fellow must submit a progress report, transcripts and a letter of recommendation, preferably from his/her advisor, confirming satisfactory completion of the most recently concluded academic interval.
15. The University must submit an invoice for each Fellowship recipient (first time Fellows as well as renewals) for each semester in order for Fellowship payments to be processed. The invoice should be submitted prior to the start of each semester to:
